ATLANTIC BROADBAND LAUNCHES FIBER EXPANSION INITIATIVE

Atlantic Broadband, the nation's eighth-largest cable operator, today announced a major growth plan that will extend fiber services into communities not previously served by the company. Atlantic Broadband will invest \$82 million in its current fiscal year to extend its reach to nearly 70,000 additional homes and businesses, providing Gig internet, home WiFi, Internet Protocol TV (IPTV) and voice services via advanced Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) technology. Franchise agreements have been obtained or are underway in multiple communities in New Hampshire and West Virginia, including the cities of Concord, Dover and Somersworth and the towns of Durham and Madbury in New Hampshire, as well as the cities of Westover and Morgantown, and the towns of Granville and Star City in West Virginia.
