BCAP President: Armstrong's Stewart to be Remembered for Kindness, Generosity

HARRISBURG – The Broadband Communications Association of Pennsylvania (BCAP) is saddened to learn about the loss of cable pioneer, former BCAP chairman and board member, and long-time Armstrong President, William Stewart of Butler, who passed away June 26, 2025.

Stewart served as BCAP chairman from 1988-90, but he was best known for leading the Butler County company for more than 30 years and his hands-on leadership approach. In addition to his corporate responsibilities, he advocated for the industry at all levels of government and was inducted into the Cable TV Pioneers. His son, Jud, is also a member, and they remain one of just five father-son members of that group.

"Bill Stewart was not only a legend in our industry, but he was also one of the most kind, generous and authentic people I have ever met," remarked BCAP President Todd Eachus. "I mourn his loss and will forever cherish the time we were able to spend together. He had a significant impact on my life, both personally and professionally."

In his retirement, Stewart was a tireless volunteer in his community, helping children and to build houses with Habitat for Humanity. He also served on the board of directors for his collegiate alma mater, Grove City College.

"Bill was one of the kindest and most generous men I have ever met," added current BCAP Chairman Fran Bradley. "He was a mentor for me. Bill will be missed by his family, and his company. The world has lost a great man."

Funeral services will be private. In addition to the BCAP and Armstrong families, his memory will be cherished by his loving family.
